

4. **Open House is Sunday! If you know of anyone who would benefit from being a member of St. Joseph please encourage them to stop by!**

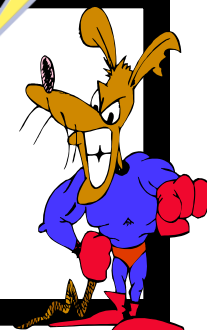

Our pretest is Wednesday 3/8 if they get 100% they do not take the test Friday 3/10



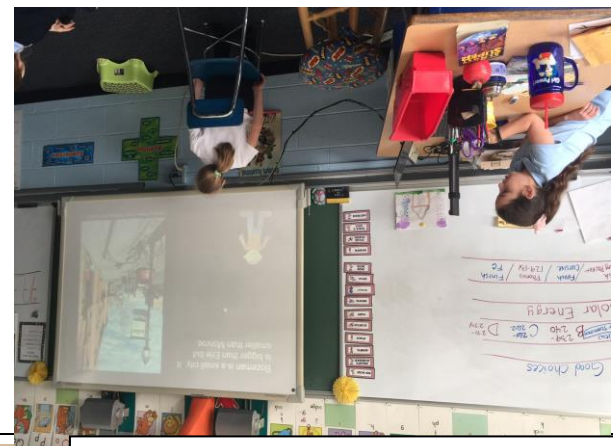
Notes from Captain Teacher:
