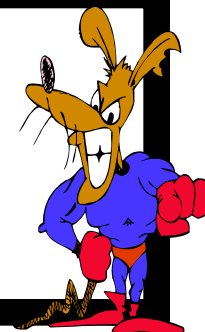


Don't Forget

4. School store is open on Wednesday and Friday!

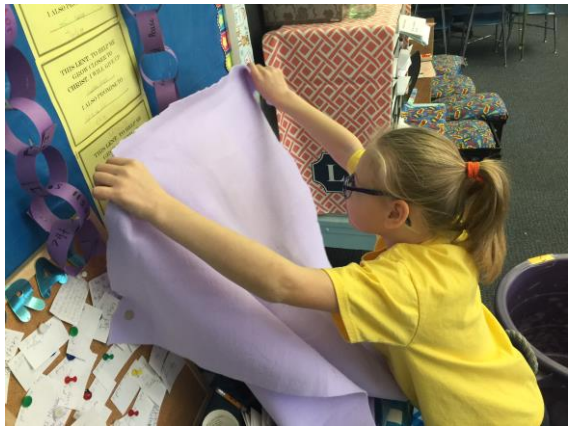

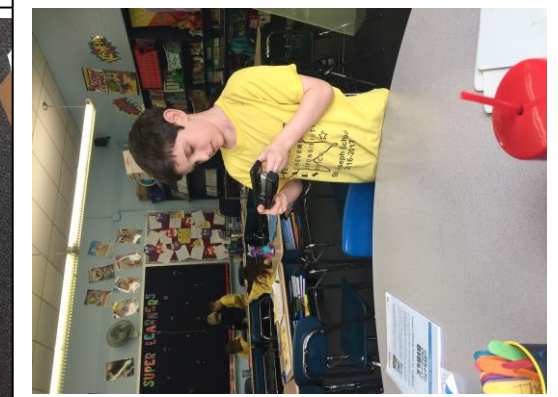
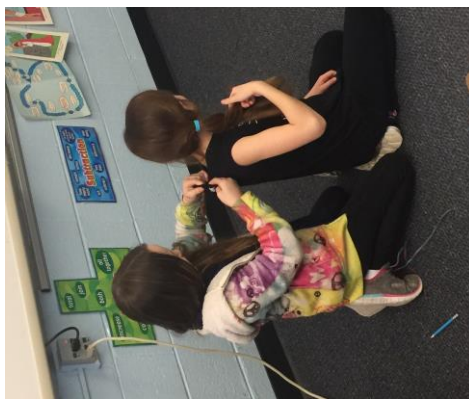

Last week the kids learned about Passiontide and about how some churches cover their statues in purple to encourage people to focus on the altar and the Eucharistic miracle.
